Daybreak Rotary Hold'em Rules

The object of the game is to increase attendance and bring in new members to the club in a fun way all can participate in.

The game is poker, "Daybreak Hold'em"

1. All members get their first card free. Those not in attendance for the first card day had one drawn for them.
2. Members earn cards by attending meetings. During 5 meetings selected at random by the membership committee, members may purchase a card for \$1.00. Only during these meetings may members in attendance purchase a card. Attend meetings regularly and the odds increase on you being there on a "card day".
3. Members earn FREE cards by bringing in new members. Once a new member has been put forth to the membership for acceptance, a card will be issued.
4. Cards/hands are to be kept track of at all times by the membership chair.
5. At year-end, two "flop" cards are selected and can be combined with any member's cards to build the best 5-card hand. The best 5-card hand wins their membership dues paid for the coming year.
6. In the event of a draw, those with the top hands will cut from a deck of cards, high card wins.
