### Club Assembly: November 22: Report — Submitted by Rod Mont

Our visitors were Glynis Hayes, president of Nanaimo North, Delores Gottenburg of Nanaimo North, and two of our three students: Anna from Spain who is staying with the Hammers and Angelina from the Netherlands who is staying with the Geneaus.

Donna Allen gave a Rotary Moment outlining details regarding our District which included such facts as we have 5200 members, 35 Canadian clubs and 50 American clubs. Donna encouraged us to attend the District Leadership Training Assembly; our club subsidizes some of the cost of attending. In addition, we need to send a representative to a sexual harassment training session in order to continue with the youth exchange program. A couple of Rotarians volunteered to take this training which will be a 2 day session running parallel with DLTA in Victoria.

In other business, the Notice of Motion from last week regarding the Brechin School project was passed, President Kris encouraged members to contact Lee Odgers regarding volunteering for bingo, Jim McIvor thanked everyone for a job well done on the Grey Cup Party which raised about \$6,300 to \$6,500, and Dave Perry reminded us to attend the fireside chat at Nicole's this week if we haven't attended another fireside chat.

President Kris indicated that the presidents of the five Nanaimo-area clubs met and were considering a five club project to buy an item worth \$12,000 to \$25,000 for the hospital. This project is eligible for an application to the District for a matching grant. A vote was taken to test the support of the club on this initiative which resulted in 15 for and 14 against. Kris will work with Nathan to come up with specific numbers in the hope of getting a clearer decision from the club.

Other business: Ron Campbell announced that he is resigning from the club because he is moving to Mexico on November 23rd. Thanks Ron for all of your work with our club! Darryl Shaw handed out a questionnaire for club members to give feedback regarding our club on membership issues. Jo-Ann Harding advised that there are two current community projects on the go: the Brechin School project and moving a tree at Travellers Lodge. If anyone has ideas for future community projects, contact Jo-Ann. Don Bonner got three volunteers to cover the Foundation table on a rotating basis.
