Lynda Kazanowski, for her Rotary Minute, thanked the club for being patient with respect to her attendance. Chris Everett announced that Pennies for Heaven will end on July 31st and a cheque presentation will be made on August 19th. President Kris advised that proofs for next year's Roster will be available in May. Wendi Ferraro volunteered to co-ordinate the Roster. Nathan Thornton gave his treasurer's report: last month we gave away \$3,000 from our gaming account. There is about \$5,000 left in this account with \$2,500 earmarked for the Children's Festival. President Kris told everyone that she was the only person who showed up on Saturday to finish the painting. There will therefore need to be another work party date set up to finish this project.
