A photo of the work group at Habitat for Humanity was circulated... thanks to those who volunteered. Christine McAuley passed around a sign-up sheet for Landtubbers. Jo Ann Harding reminded members that Saturday July 14th we will be painting at the Nanaimo Conservatory of Music. There will be a potluck fellowship at Donna & Nelson Allen's place in the evening following the work party.



Brian Kirkhope introduced District Governor Norm Watts and his wife Marion Watts, both of whom are Rotarians from the Rotary Club of Qualicum Beach. This was DG Norm's first official meeting to a Rotary club in his capacity as DG and he encouraged us to keep track of our club history and to



let the community know about the good work that we are doing. Our involvement with Interact was acknowledged as well as the hard work done by such members as Brian Kirkhope, Don Bonner, Ken Hammer, Denise Larson and Christine McAuley at the District level. DG Norm has recently returned from the Rotary International Convention in Salt Lake City and he came back feeling very proud to be a Rotarian. Of the 540 Rotary districts worldwide, our district of 86 clubs ranks third in terms of giving donations to the annual fund. DG Norm encouraged each member to find a new person to bring into Rotary and presented Denise Larson, Rod Mont & Donna Allen with Rotary sponsor pins to recognize their efforts in bringing in

new members. DG Norm also highlighted the Polio campaign. From 350,000 cases per year, the number of new polio cases is now down to 2,000 per year. As was demonstrated by the resurgence of malaria, the war against polio is not won until it is completely gone. Rotary has an extensive network of 32,000 clubs which is the envy of other organizations and DG Norm asked us to focus on what we have to share with Rotary. In particular, he suggested that we do make-ups at other clubs and learn about such Rotary gems as the friendship exchanges, actions groups and the ambassadorial scholarship program.
