Meeting Notes

The July 18th meeting was held at the Harbourview Days Inn, the first of three new possible locations for our meetings. Next week we will be meeting at Mom's Cape Breton Kitchen. Christine McAuley advised that she had attended the Rotary Youth Exchange training seminar. Our District 5020 has one of the largest youth exchange programs in the world and Christine reminded us to invite the three in-coming students in our family activities. President Donna announced that the cheque for \$2,500 has now been given to the Child Development Centre and a cheque has been given to Daryl Knievel for the benches. Bill Brendon reminded us to read the District's policy regarding Rotary clubs dealing with youth. It was moved by Bill Brendon, seconded by Karin Mattern to adopt the District policy. This will be discussed and voted on at the July 25th meeting. President Donna passed around a Rotary test regarding various Rotary "firsts" including the first Rotary club, the first international Rotary club and the first Rotary club in a non-English-speaking country.



Wendi Ferrero announced that the fellowship night at Nelson & Donna Allen's place on July 14th was a success with 16 members in attendance. Wendi also recognized Dave Perry and Donna Allen for attending the public relations meeting for the Nanaimo area Rotary clubs. Examples of some proposed ads on bus benches were passed around. Jo-Ann Harding gave a detailed report on club service which included the goals we have set for this year plus several topics including: youth exchange - it is important to include the visiting students in activities; and Summer Song - this fundraising event will be held at the Departure Bay Activity Centre on Saturday, August 25th and will feature Decadence, a 10 piece jazz band. Jo-Ann handed out a sheet for members to write down any silent auction items that they have for Summer Song.
