## Meeting Notes - October 10th

Daryl Stech, for his Rotary minute, gave us some historical background regarding Rotary in our area including the facts that Seattle was the 4th Rotary club in the world, Victoria was 90th and that the Nanaimo club was chartered in 1920. Our Rotary district was started in 1909 and since then has been broken into smaller districts. President Donna passed around a picture of the Charter members for Daybreak Rotary taken at the Charter Night in January 1996.

Henri Van Amerongen was formally introduced to the club by Rod Mont. Henri was sponsored by Ken Hammer. Nelson Allen conducted the induction of Henri into Nanaimo Daybreak Rotary. Welcome, Henri!

President Donna advised that she has received an email from Nicole Gosselin in Ethiopia - Nicole is promising to keep Don Bonner busy.

Nathan Thornton presented his treasurer's report and advised that revenues are on track for the year.

Bill Brendon advised that the first fireside chat will be held on Thursday, October 25th at Jo Ann Hardings place, 1572 Knight Court starting at 7 pm. The club was reminded that there will be a total of four firesides and all members are encouraged to attend at least one of them. Sign up sheets will be available next week.

Dave Perry held up a copy of the Mid-Island Canpages, a telephone directory. The publishers of Canpages have given a full page ad for the Nanaimo area Rotary clubs at no cost. Dave also announced that he is looking for people who wish to be on the executive for the next Rotary year which starts July 1, 2008. Election of next year's board will be held on December 5th.

Wendi Ferrero gave her fellowship report which included the Spa weekend (October 20 & 21) and a possible Christmas fellowship event at Yellow Point Theatre. Wendi also advised that our regular club meeting on October 31st will be a fellowship meeting and guests are welcome to attend.

Jo Ann Harding announced that there will be three \$700 scholarships presented to third year music students from the proceeds of Summer Song. Members were encouraged to discuss the future of Summer Song at the firesides. One possibility is to move the date of the event so that we can get better ticket sales than we would in July or August. The committee is also looking at ways to get Malaspina University-College involved in some aspects of Summer Song. Jo Ann advised that 17 people showed up for daffodil planting and that the Grey Cup party will take place on November 25th.

Nelson Allen advised that the World Community Service committee will be raising awareness of international projects to our members, are planning to add at least one new program, will fund a Shelterbox, will continue to support the AIDS orphans in Zimbabwe, and are looking at doing a multi-club project with other Rotary clubs from central Vancouver Island.
