## Meeting Notes - October 24th

Lynda Kazanowski, for her Rotary minute, discussed the Four Way Test and related its relevance to her classification of banking. The Four Way Test was written in 1932 and has been translated into over 100 languages.

Cindy Stanley gave her classification talk. Cindy was born in New Westminster and has had an active lifestyle. She started competitive swimming at age 7 and for a short time held a Canadian backstroke record for her age group. When Cindy was 10, her mother was diagnosed with breast cancer and Cindy learned the importance of family as everyone had to contribute to such things as cooking dinner. Cindy was married to Don at age 19 and is still married to him. Their family, which includes daughters Jennifer and Jessica, is active with hiking and kayaking. Cindy got her first degree from UBC with majors in history and physical education and a minor in music. She described herself as a behaviour specialist - one who looks beyond the behaviour itself to identify what a child is trying to communicate. After seven years in Prince George, where her family spent summers in a cabin without electricity or water, Cindy started as a high school teacher in Nanaimo and taught at Barsby, Woodlands, Wellington and NDSS. Cindy met Donna Allen at NDSS where they developed the peer helper group. After receiving her masters degree from James Cook University in Australia, Cindy had her first experience as an administrator at Fairview Elementary and since January 2007 has been principal at Park Avenue Elementary. Her husband, Don, works for CUPE which leads to interesting discussions at home and the two of them are avid sailors. They recently bought the "boat of their dreams" and hope to do lots of sailing when they eventually retire. Cindy stated that Rotary has "always been there when needed in the community" and after Daybreak Rotary funded a student from her school who needed but couldn't afford dental surgery, Cindy decided that she wanted to be part of our club. Welcome to Daybreak Rotary, Cindy!

Brian Kirkhope got a call last week from Bruce Williams regarding a pumpkin event which has been cancelled at Government House in Victoria.
