Meeting Notes - June 18th

The motions regarding the Nanaimo & Region Disability Resource Centre receiving funds from the Landtubbers Race and the \$1,000 to the Boys & Girls Club for the golf tournament passed. Bill Brendon announced that Rotarians who are proposing club events or projects should be filling out an activity form providing details as to the event or project so that the proposed event or project can be reviewed by the executive and then brought to the club. Bill outlined the Mainstage ticket project: we have 40 tickets to sell for \$15 each for any of the 10 plays at Mainstage which will take place July 4 - 11. The club will make \$5 for each ticket sold.

Don Bonner announced that the club reached its Rotary Foundation goal of \$125 per member. We also contributed \$605 to Polio Plus. The club goals next year will be to add Benefactors - a Benefactor is someone who pledges in their Will to provide at least \$1,000 US to the Rotary Foundation. Jo-Ann Harding, as club service director, thanked the club for its work during the year on club projects. Wendi Ferrero announced that she had met with Rod Mont and Sheila Forrest to assist Sheila with ideas regarding being next year's director of club service.

Nathan Thornton provided financial statements for the club and advised that gaming revenues and expenses met budget numbers. On the general account, we ended up about \$2,000 short on revenues but expenses also came in lower than budgeted. A draft budget for next year was discussed.

Rod Mont announced that Swing into Spring has tentatively been scheduled for the second Saturday in March, 2009 at Vancouver Island University. There was a lot of discussion regarding whether or not the ticket price should go from \$40 as it was last year to \$100. Rod will keep the club updated as the budget for this event gets more into focus. Swing into Spring will have a lot more support from Vancouver Island University than we received last year.

Ron Blank announced that Landtubbers will be seeking \$2 donations at the malls. Wendi Ferrero updated the club as to Dave Thompson - Dave is in ICU with a ruptured appendix and is not currently taking visitors as he needs to rest. Christine McAuley advised that the students are leaving next week. There will be a farewell picnic at Bowen Park at 5 pm on June 25th.

Don Bonner reminded everyone that next week's meeting will be held at the Nanaimo Youth Services Association (NYSA) building. Don also said that if anyone is not getting the email regarding the Bulletin, they should check their spam setting and their junk box. If anyone needs help getting the Bulletin notifications, contact Don. Bruce Mede did the honours as Sargeant-at-arms.
