Fundraising Proposal from Patrick ...

For consideration at Wednesday's meeting...

I'm preparing to complete my tax return and I find that I have a couple of boxes of documents that I need shredded. (And it's not that I don't want Revenue Canada to see them!!) Likely there are other people in the same situation. I was reminded of a fundraiser that we used at one of my former clubs - a community shredding opportunity. I checked with Island Document Storage and Shredding in Ladysmith and they would bring a shredding truck to a location selected by us in north Nanaimo on a Saturday so that people could bring their documents and paper to be shredded. The shredding is done on the spot, so there's no issue with confidential papers being removed from your supervision. They charge \$8 per bankers box of paper from which they would rebate \$4 to us. This amount is pro-rated by weight for paper in bags or non-standard containers. We would be responsible for advertising the event to the community and for traffic control on the day. With the right amount and kind of communication I think we could clear about \$2000, which, coincidentally, is our club's commitment to Polio Plus for this year! I'm thinking of a Saturday in late April or May for about 4 or 5 hours in the North Nanaimo Town Centre parking lot. Your thoughts and ideas!
