*Meeting Notes - June 30th**submitted by Karin Mattern*

Denise Larson asked for introduction of guests: Neil Sorsdahl introduced Gail Wilson, soon to be a member. The meeting was a Club social since it was the 5th Wednesday of the month.

We met in the Longwood Theatre at Origins instead of the dining room. Patrick Maguire explained that we have had trouble with power point and Origins is not keen on mounting a permanent screen. They do breakfast meetings in the theatre for another group so we're trying it out.

Discussion followed:

Karin: Why not have breakfast in the dining room and then move here? It seems a lot of extra work for the staff to bring food in here and set up the tables.

Patrick: It disrupts the meeting and we lose 5-7 minutes. Many will leave early and miss the presentation. Another option would be to spend \$1500 on a projector and screen.

Bruce: Could build a valence with a pull down screen. Discuss with Origins. He's upgrading his projector and could donate his to the club. Could also build a bigger storage box for the screen and projector.

Rod: Likes the other room much better; not liking the idea of changing venues or moving mid-meeting. Let's try to work out a solution. Bruce's offer is generous. We could buy a new screen. Not a great idea to share with other clubs. Too much chance of miscommunication.

Bill asked: How much is new screen? Not much.

Consensus was get projector new or from Bruce. Buy a screen and store at Origin.

Party Program:

Bill gave an update. Application for the grant for the Party Program at NRGH went into the district. Budget is approximately \$3750. Invitation goes to grade 10 students and teachers. They are separated into groups of 5 or 6 kids and tour rooms in the hospital with experts on MVA's or whatever the cause of them ending up in those rooms. Also the morgue and a wrecked vehicle. Very well organized. Will take place in September. We can send some people to guide kids around and make sure they stay with the group.
