 It was coined by Herbert Taylor, a Chicago Rotarian in 1932. It was designed as an instrument to foster respect and understanding as well as a guide for right thinking and friendlier relationships. Initially, he used the test for himself in his personal life and then encouraged all the employees of his struggling company to use the Four Way Test. In 1932 his company was insolvent and he had to borrow \$6,100 personally for corporate working capital needs. The company was able to return to profitability and was extremely successful in the ensuing years.

Anna Owen distributed a copy of the club’s Financial Statements.

Jeff Boegel informed the club of the Texas Hold-em playing and dealing clinic scheduled for this Saturday from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm at 3154 Barons Road.

has about 1200 residences. There is very little available fresh water in the village and no running water at the school. A latrine was started for the school but never finished as there was no available water. A bamboo forest behind the school is currently used as the latrine.

In November 2011, Bev and Lea went to Sedwa to spearhead the construction of a cistern at the fresh water source (creek) and run pipes to the school so the latrine can be functional. To date, they have raised \$1,500 which has been used to purchase the necessary supplies. These supplies are in place, but another \$5,000 needs to be raised to complete the project. Bev and Lea stressed how grateful the local villagers are for the help that they have provided.

Patrick Maguire presented our guest speakers with two children's books that will be donated to the local library in their name.
