and networking. She is learning that we lead ourselves into diversity, and that leadership is a journey that works with your core values.

Each nine month programme costs \$2,000 with \$200 coming from the participants. They began with a two day retreat, then monthly leadership days with themes that highlight leadership knowledge, skills & attitudes. "As a single, working mother," Tara said "It's taught me to be accountable to what I commit."

Students also develop community projects, partnering with the befitting organization, and get to apply their new skills. Each team is provided with a coach who is a facilitator & mentor. Projects this year include increasing volunteers working with Duncan's Providence Farm and Education on safe riding for outdoor Motor Sports. Tara's team, named "Shift Happens", is working with Ladysmith Downtown Business Association and has developed a 'buy local' spending initiative that invites the community to "Buy 10% more in Ladysmith!"

Russ Burke closed with thanking Ken for his founding membership and continuing support from this organization. Karin Mattern presented Tara with our book that we donate to a children's library in her name.

50/50 now up to \$1185, says Darryl Shaw. No luck today.

Neil Sorsdahl noted that Sgt Don was like Mao, teaching by negative example, but got to pay for calling Russ another name. Russ got to pay for the shameless promotion of Western Canadian Bank logo showing when he spoke on the presented video.
