Rotary Minute

Neil Sorsdahl queried the club as to the definition of a sustaining member. Don Bonner advised that it is member that has committed to contribute \$100 US per year to Foundation leading to a Paul Harris Fellowship upon reaching \$1000 US. Neil advised that the annual contribution goal can be achieved weekly by paying in \$2. Alternatively, \$125 Cdn will be included on our annual club dues invoice and can be paid to meet the sustaining member goal for the year. Our club invoice for fiscal 2013 will be distributed shortly.

Club Assembly

Vocational Service

Dave Thompson confirmed that the club has committed to distribute \$10,000 of our accumulated surplus by the end of this fiscal year. He advises that he has received several submissions for the use of the funds and he will present them to the club next week for our consideration. Dave reiterated that the club will make the final decision on how these funds are distributed.

Bill Brendon advised that the board has decided to distribute an additional \$3,500 to the club committees for use this year.

Treasurer's Report

Anna Jones (nee Owens) reported that the recent shredding fundraiser netted \$1616. She advised that at the end of April our club has \$16,456 in our gaming account and \$37,814 in the general account.

Membership

Rod Mont advised that he has distributed a nomination form for Rotarian of the Year. He will tabulate the nominations and based on the results will put a ballot together naming up to 3 club members for a vote next week.

Rod also advised that Dave Perry, Val Lennox and Tiffany Harsma have resigned from the club. He also confirmed that Bruce Mede will be returning. Last month's club attendance was a stellar 93%.

Kids on the Block

Jeff Boegel advised that the merger between Mid Island Abilities and the Independence Living Societies has completed. He advised that the puppets, training and DVD for the Kids on the Block Project is complete, but they are in need of puppeteers as the Interact Club is unable to commit in this regard. Jeff indicated that the Woodlands Drama Teacher has advised that the students may be able to help in this capacity. Jeff also advised that our club will involved in the Empire Day Parade with puppeteers on our float.

Secretary

Neil Sorsdahl confirmed that sponsorships for our Golf Tourney are going well, but we need golfers. He advised that we have a brochure which he asked our members to take and display in their businesses.

Neil also confirmed that the upcoming Installation is scheduled for June 2, 2012 @ Cottonwood golf course. Cocktails @ 5pm and dinner @ 6pm. Cost \$10 and kids are welcome. In addition, a special Rotary rate has been negotiated for golf: \$35 green fee and \$12 for a power cart.
