### *Poker Tourney this week...*

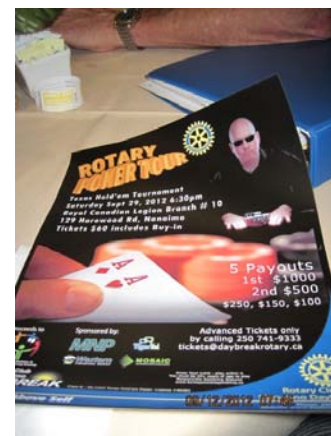
