Sara is quite accomplished in English. Who knows, Daryl Knievel & Mandy may jump in for Dec-March. Rod said Sara is a can-person and nice to deal with.

Rod presented info on two of his Community Service Projects:

Soap Committee: three dedicated teams of Rotarians collect 150 - 200 lbs of soap and shampoo from eight hotel/motels each month. Christine Craigie, Darryl Shaw, Nelson and Donna Allen, Patrick and, occasionally, Don Bonner and Sher Hulobowich bring the material to Patrick's garage, who then makes arrangements for Nanaimo Ladysmith collections to be transported to Disaster Aid in Victoria. There it's sterilized, repackaged with face cloths added to the package. They are distributed to an aid-needing site including our Guatemala initiative.

Book Boxes: Weekly, five teams glean their book donation boxes and recycle magazines, encyclopedias, old textbooks and sometimes plain "#\$*&***" garbage. Collecting, sorting and dropping off the marketable books at Literacy Vancouver Island "Well Read Books" takes from 1-2 hours. Teams: Doug & family Lum for Toys R Us entrance Woodgrove Centre, Jaap Tuinman & Francine Frisson for back of London Drugs in North Town Centre, Kris Rongve & Karin Mattern at grocery store entrance to Country Club Centre, Eileen Tatton, Martin Hoffman & Terry Rogers at parking lot Country Grocer Dufferin and Ron does Country Grocer Chase River and Coastal Community CU Southgate. Literacy E.D. Rebecca Kirk says our donations generate about \$60,000 annual revenue.
