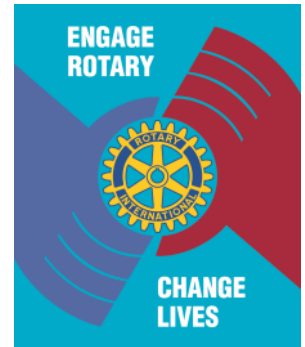

Rob Waine spoke on Rotary Youth Leadership Academy (RYLA) held annually in Tacoma Washington. Our District 5020 and adjacent Dist. 5030 select and sponsor 140 grade 10-12 students to attend a four day conference. RYLA emphasizes leadership, citizenship, and personal growth. Students get to share an inspiring experience with tomorrow's future leaders, receive mentoring to further develop their talents and abilities and accomplish personal goals through teamwork? They eat and sleep on campus and get to connect with like-minded teens. This year's speakers included a holocaust survivor and the disabled snow sit-ski inventor who is now developing golf opportunities for veterans with disabilities.

Lynda Kazanowski has been our RYLA Club rep for several past years. She gets really involved with selection of the high school student candidates for our five local clubs. Next February is the candidate selection date. Tell your friends with High School students. Ken Hammer suggests we need to double our investment in future Rotarians by sponsoring 10 students, rather than five.

Several of us have had the opportunity to accompany the students to Tacoma. Though the candidates are already amazing people within their communities, you can hear and feel the difference a weekend of focus and training with like-minded students has accomplished.

Neil Sorsdahl gave the final numbers for our "Golf fore Nanaimo Youth" Tourney and proceeds were in excess of \$11.5K. Though the numbers of golfers was less than expected, sponsors were magnificent. Thank-you all!!! Better yet, THANK-YOU NEIL!

NYSA Board President Jameel thanked us for our deeds and funds that help families. Lee was also thankful for our sponsorship of his Leadership VI training. He is thrilled with his new knowledge and the potential impact of being a leader in our community.
