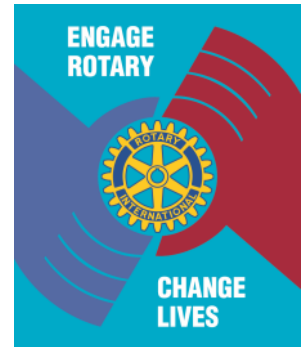

Doug and Donna shared their stories as volunteer tutors and told us about the rewarding success stories of changed lives. Over 200 people (and 200 tutors) each week!! They are looking for more tutors for the Fall training workshops.

Also introduced to say a few words was a guest of San, Stephen Struthers who is raising money for the Hospital Foundation. Stephen told us about an exciting new event called the Dinner of Light scheduled for November 8th. They are selling 100 tickets only to this event at \$250 per person or \$2000 a table. Slated for the Nanaimo golf course, guests will be treated to a great meal, wine pairing and topped off with a fireworks display. No other money will be solicited at the event so the \$250 is all it is.
