Dear Daybreak Rotary:

Thank you so much for having me to do a presentation on the continually development of Harewood Centennial Park. I am afraid I did not give you the correct total of the skate park. It will be closer to 600,000 to 700,000. We will have 130,000.

The designer that I mentioned got the contract. He was saying 45 dollars per sq feet, we have 12,000 sq feet to work with with a little wiggle room. This is a youth park, we have a large community of skate boarders and a large amount of BMX riders they want something for them as well, the skaters can use it to. It will be interesting what the design will look like.

I am anxious to come show you with the design and construction costs and a complete financial breakdown. I was wondering if I could bring the designer with me so he can answer any questions you have of cost etc. It will take about a month for him Kil Dion from Newline Out of Vancouver to have the design ready. We will still be doing it in phases. I also have to meet with Parks and Rec to clarify some things. I am so glad that the Rotary and HNA especially myself are on the same page concerning the youth and helping them in this endeavor. Perhaps we could sometime towards the end of October. Again thank you for your hospitality.

Our meeting started with Pres Eileen Tatton at the bell.

Patrick Maguire showed the presentation of Nobel Peace Prize Laureate and former president of Costa Rica Dr. Óscar Arias at our Rotary International Conference World Peace Symposium in Brazil this past June.

(Dr. Arias was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1987 for his plan to put an end to the civil wars that were devastating Central America. In August 1987, the peace plan was approved by Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. It aimed to establish free elections, safeguards for human rights, and an end to foreign interference in the internal affairs of those countries.)

Dr Arias reminded the gathering that in the words of founder Paul Harris, "The most virtuous war is the war against war." His goal is to seek peace all over the planet by waging war against war. That is: war against poverty, war against environmental destruction, war against nature and war against indifference. Dr Arias is now a Rotarian in San Jose, Costa Rica and realizes the power of 1,200,000 people from all walks of life with their commitments to world peace and poverty. "The force of history is on our side," and challenged us to go fourth and build peace in the world. Patrick closed with "the mark of a good speech is that it disturbs & challenges us to do better."
