Don Bonner informed the meeting of RYLA which stands Rotary Youth Leadership Awards. Five students from the island go down to Tacoma May 12 to 15, 2016. It is an opportunity for young adults, between 18 & 30, to participate in a four day, leadership camp with like-minded individuals to form lasting friendships, hear from professional speakers, develop as a leader, grow as a person and have fun.

In addition, in November there is going to a junior RYLA in Crofton for younger students.

Kayley and Megan Guest speakers

Thirteen student nurses and 2 guides are about to travel to San Miguel de Allende, in Mexico for a five week internship. They have partnered with Apoyo a NGO which operates a facility that addresses substance abuse, domestic violence and sexual and reproduction health education issues. The goal of the student internship is to develop leadership and relationship skills as well as promote healthy choices and develop sustainable programs in Mexico.

In addition, there is daycare facility operated in San Miguel called Casa de Los Angeles for women that cannot afford daycare for their children. It is also a safe place for women in the local community. Upon return, the nurses hope that their internship in Mexico will serve to foster global mindedness and support as well as encourage cultural awareness in our community. In addition, a program will be developed to share the learning gained in Mexico with the peers that could not attend the internship. They are looking for donations to help fund the Mexico initiatives in San Miguel. They anticipate that \$3000 is needed and to date, they have raised \$2000.

Nelson advised that at an impromptu World Community meeting held during the talk the committee had unanimously voted to fund \$500 from our club to help reach the \$3000 goal.

Jeff Boegel confirmed that our Poker event is scheduled for Sunday May 1/16.
