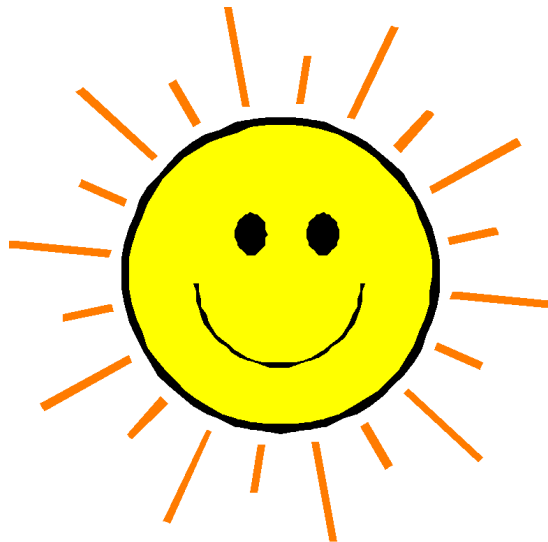
Shandra also is a part of the Young Professionals Network (YPN) and it is their goal to pursue more projects with more established clubs, such as Rotary.
