Dave Perry provided a Rotary Moment, using the Rotary wheel to symbolize our community and we Rotarians represented by the cogs. It's our joining with others that allows us to work with others - the cogs of one wheel mesh with the cogs of another. "Work with others & you will make a difference".

Don Dempson was our guest speaker; providing a description of his work with the Calgary Stampede. Don has experience with CODA (Calgary Olympic facilities), the Calgary Tower, Calgary tourism and the Calgary Stampede as Director of Television for the Stampede Rodeo. Don has worked the Director's booth for the past 20 years. The work of directing TV for the Calgary Stampede has grown to a very hectic, pressure filled job working to coordinate four TV networks and the number of on-site video boards. This is a 12 month job, starting at the end of one Stampede to organize for the next year's event. The rodeo committee is comprised of 33 fully-volunteer members – 8 of which are Rotarians. The Stampede is viewed by 3.8 million people on TV and hosts 25,000 people in the stands each day. Although Don loves the Stampede, he admits that he is not a cowboy and is allergic to horses!
