Robin, a mining engineer, is originally from England but has lived in Zimbabwe for most of his life. He is a member of a Rotary Club in Harare and gave us a geography lesson of his adopted homeland. Highlights include Victoria Falls, Hwange National Park and Lake Kariba. Robin advised of the prosthetic leg project that his club and a British Rotary Club co-sponsored. With the power of matching grants the modest seed money contributed by the two clubs grew to \$58,000us. Their project provides affordable leg prosthetics, originally invented in India about 50 years ago, for those unable to afford much more expensive alternatives. The cost of the prosthetic is \$400 to \$500 and most recipients can walk immediately.
