This means we are actively searching for keen, motivated, and dedicated Rotarians who wish to serve at the district level in what many have called "the best job in Rotary": the Assistant (Area) Governor. To help facilitate adequate training, support, and mentorship **we would like to identify interested candidates interested in serving in the role of Assistant Governor as early as possible.**

As a district we would like to provide transition time by inviting incoming Assistant Governors to participate in our pre-PETS meetings along with the current sitting Assistant Governor (this orientation session is hosted in your local Area during September and October.

We will also extend an invitation for incoming appointments to attend our District Council meeting this September 23 (Victoria) and participate in a short overview training session for 'new' Assistant Governors following the Council Meeting and prior to dinner that evening.

Qualifications:

Candidates for appointment must have completed a full year as a club president, or at least six months as a charter president. Assistant Governors have responsibilities to both the District Governor and their Area Rotary clubs.

Assistant Governors are eligible to be reappointed for two additional concurrent terms, subject to the approval of the governor for those years.
