All the money the foundation raises goes into 3 buckets:

Polio Plus

Funds going into this program are never used for anything else except Polio programs

Annual Fund has assets of approximately \$300 million (the interest alone covers the Rotary administration) as well the interest is used for projects

We want every Rotarian to give to this fund every year

Our district contribution to the annual fund are about \$500,000

Endowment Fund assets of about \$1 billion dollars (generally from bequests through estates)

The interest funds only are spent and used for projects

We learned about the Paul Harris Fellowship and how you can gain points.

Engagement – our clubs goal for 2017/18 for \$3,000.

We have 28 Paul Harris Fellows,

we have 2 bequests society members

we have 1 Major Donor.

Easiest ways to give – Rotary Direct – 1 go on line and sign up (don't know your number, check the clubs website or write to Don Bonner, he'll tell you your number – thanks Don!)

Bashir from the Parksville Club, Paul Harris Society is the representative for the society – spoke briefly about the society
