**Rotary Minute**

Nelson advised that, in their trip to Maui, Donna and he attended the Kihei-Wailea Rotary meeting. They learned that many people drown every year in Maui. The majority are middle aged males who have heart attacks or strokes while snorkeling, not appreciating the strenuous nature of the activity. The Kihei-Wailea Rotary club has addressed this issue by funding GPS rescue tubes at the beaches to assist swimmers in stress.

**Guest Speaker**

Paul Geneau from the Nanaimo North is the Committee Chair for Youth Exchange in Nanaimo/Lantzville. Paul advised that all clubs involved in Youth programs are obliged to have a Youth Protection Officer and must receive a Youth Protection presentation every year. Our Youth Protection Officer is Graham Calder.

Paul directed us to the District 5020 website and specifically Youth Services and Youth Protection. You can access the Rotary Youth Protection Guideline and the Statement of Conduct for Working with Youth. The Guideline covers Youth Exchange, RYLA, Interact, Rotaract and all individual club activities involving other youth activities.

All individuals with continued contact with youth must be screened by the District and approved as Volunteers. The screening includes a criminal record check, youth protection training and three personal references as to the volunteer's character.

Paul stressed the importance of safety and well-being of the youth is the most critical issue. If anyone becomes aware of any alleged abuse or harassment of a youth, they should ensure the youth is no longer at risk. They should remain calm and document the facts in a nonjudgmental fashion. The Youth Protection officer should then be contacted immediately. Should the abuse or harassment be of a sexual nature, the police should be contacted immediately.
