 Total project \$7000 plus US.  
 14 Million people live there, approximately size of Vancouver Island, 60% Latino and 40% indigenous Mayan.  
 Economy – income \$5,200 average, workers make less than \$50 a week, 56% living in poverty  
 Finding big multinationals converting farms for bio fuel.  
 San Lucas Toliman – where projects are based, 10,000 people.  
 Projects – wash stations and electrical poles to bring electricity to the houses.
