Ev distributed the Committee list and advised of the Sept 11 BBQ at the Yacht club for the NZ Friendship Exchange. Ev also advised of the opportunity to obtain individual Rotary business cards.

Rod Mont advised that our August 22 breakfast meeting will be at the Tillicum Lelum location, 475 10<sup>th</sup> Street. Details to follow.

**Guest Speakers Nanaimo BMX Association**

Chris Barfoot confirmed that the track at Beban was built in 1989. The original starting gate is very dated and not to the standards of current facilities. They are planning on building a new starting gate, which is budgeted to cost \$60,000, with all required upgrades. Currently, \$18,000 has been raised and the Association has applied for matching gaming grants for infrastructure improvements. They are looking for donations of money, in-kind service and labour. Chris provided a sponsorship package and advised that all sponsors will receive recognition both at the facility & on social media.



**Guest Speaker John Horn**

John, the social planner for the city of Nanaimo, advised that the latest homeless census indicates that the number of homeless in Nanaimo has increased to 335, up from 174 in 2016. Other stats show that 70% are male and 89% live alone. In addition, about 1/2 have been homeless for more than a year. John advised that the city has a five-year strategic plan to address the situation. Part of the plan includes increasing supported housing, but John cautioned that when homeless individuals are put in supported housing, they lose their social network and need assistance in building new networks.



Other issues affecting the growth in homeless numbers include the greater influence of both mental illness and drug use. Currently, social agencies are running at full capacity and greater resources are required. Provincial help is being solicited.

John also advised that 31% of the homeless are indigenous and they are now seeing older women, without other issues, now living on the street, as their pension income is insufficient to pay for rent.
