**Guest Speaker**

**San** introduced our guest speaker **Rob Rose** from the Rotary Club in Bellevue, WA, who joined Rotary in 1986. Rob has been to Nepal 25 times and presented President Ev with a gift from Nepal. A beautiful wool shawl.

Rob was introduced to Rotary in 1975/76 as an exchange student as he spent 8 months in Calcutta India...he said it was life altering trip. In 1997, Rob went to Nepal as a volunteer photographer and met Olga and her two daughters, who were blind. Rob soon learned that having a disability in Nepal meant in your past life you had sinned. There was no Gov't support for disabled people and with political instability and poverty people with a disability were not treated as a regular citizens.

Rob started a 3-year project, 2009 through to 2012. The disability awareness campaign. 30 rotary clubs in Nepal and 30 rotary in the US helped out. His mission was to change the perception of disabilities. Once people worked with disabled people, they soon forgot that they had a disability. Another project Rob was behind was the universal accessibility playground in Bellevue. An inspiration playground where kids with disabilities could play, have fun and feel like a normal kid.

Rob has organized an 18 day tour, tour guide included, in Nepal leaving October 27<sup>th</sup>, There is some hiking, and tours, but you will be working with kids with disabilities, as well as working with other rotarians and rotoractors. Graham and Viki may be going.
