President Ev Boegh opened the meeting with 'O Canada' accompanied by Rod Mont. Our guests were then introduced including our presenters Rikki Wyllie of Tillicum Lelum with students Kayley Mitchell and Keanu Johnson, and guests Brandon Kolybaba and Dominic Wittenberg (son of Ed).

Donna Allen provided a Rotary Moment, which directed us through the planning for the upcoming Christmas Auction Beer and Burger. The event will be this coming Wednesday (December 12) from 6:00 til 9:00. The event will be held at the Old City Station Pub on Skinner Street. There will not be a morning meeting on this day.

Silent Auction still needs items. These can be brought to the event on Wednesday. Donations of a bottle of wine for the "wine sleigh" (draw) should be given to Christine C.

Announcements:

All club members are expected to complete the on-line training for Rotary Youth Protection. On-line information has been sent to your email by the secretary.

Criminal background checks are expected to be completed as well. Bill has a personalized letter and application form for each member. Get these documents from Bill to complete the process. Provide your completed check to Bill Hardy.

Program:

Our program provided an overview of the work and opportunities of Tillicum Lelum and the Aboriginal Friendship Centre. Rikki Wyllie gave a presentation starting with her own involvement with Tillicum Lelum since childhood and now employed for the past 15 years.

The services started in 1965 as a coffeehouse organized as a gathering place for urban people. Tillicum Lelum has grown so that it now has more than 70 full-time employees working with "off reserve" population. They have five locations providing education, health services, daycare, centre for young mothers, a transition house for young mothers, and a youth safe house. Their Nanaimo location was the first aboriginal health centre in British Columbia.

Working with youth, they provide summer camps, drop-in centre, various boys, girls and men's groups, early childhood development support, subsidized housing for adults and youths, preschool education, scholarships and bursaries. Services are focused on the "off reserve" aboriginal population. Seventy percent of the aboriginal population lives off-reserve.

A fire in the Youth Centre is the most pressing of the current issues. A new home for these services is urgently required. Funding is provided by "partners", grants and contracts for services.

Keanu Johnson comes from Gold River area. Keanu described his involvement with Tillicum Lelum since his time in daycare through to the youth programs.

Kayley Mitchell attends Barsby Secondary School. Her mom grew up with Tillicum Lelum and Kayley has followed in growing up through the services. Kayley is now employed there.
