President Ev Boegh opened the meeting with 'O Canada' accompanied by Rod Mont. Our guests were then introduced including Jason Bradley from the Nanaimo Downtown Rotary club, (Jason is the head of Rotary Youth Exchange for our area), Rotary Exchange Students Ayu Fijiwara, Dorien Abbekerk and Emile - who arrived from Campbell River. The entire Rogers family was in attendance with Terry introducing wife Jodi, son Shane and daughter Lauren; all familiar to our club. President Ev also introduced Nicole, a VIU student who has volunteered to support our club's social media efforts.

Announcements: The club is looking for volunteers to assist with the upcoming semester of the P.A.R.T.Y. program at the hospital; particularly those who can donate some afternoon time. See Patrick for details.

The January 23rd club meeting will include awarding of Paul Harris Fellowships.

President Ev introduced a motion for the club to adopt "Family Memberships". This motion was passed unanimously by the Board:

MOTION: That the Rotary Club of Nanaimo adopt a Family Membership model as follows:
 An immediate family member of an existing member may join the Club as a family member. The individual immediate family member fee will be 50% of the regular membership fee, pro-rated. The fee for additional immediate members in the same family will be 25% pro-rated. A family member will be inducted into the Club and receive all privileges and opportunities as a regular member.

Moved by Rod Fay, seconded by Doug Pearson. Motion carried and effective immediately.

Program: Dorien Abbekerk our Rotary Exchange Student from the Netherlands provided our program. The presentation was both educational and entertaining.

Dorien opened her presentation with a video which explained, in witty fashion, the difference between Holland and the Netherlands.

The Netherlands is only 1/24 the size of British Columbia, yet has a population of 17 million people. Bikes are used for transportation, not recreation. Dorien also noted the difference in our recent Christmas holiday as in the Netherlands they do not decorate for Christmas, this is just a time with family.



Dorien's interest in Rotary Exchange started a year before arriving here. Her parents were supportive of her interest, although Dorien had considered that they might object. Dorien completed the process of training and preparation, however her initial sponsorship did not materialize. She was then sponsored by a Rotary club in Turkey, which allowed her to arrive here in Nanaimo.

Dorien spoke of the many trips during her time here; Sproat Lake, Butchart Gardens, a football game in Vancouver. She closed her presentation with a video of the Rotary Exchange Students on a trip to southern California.
