President Ev Boegh opened the meeting with 'O Canada' accompanied by Rod Mont. Our guests this morning were Josh Ritter from R W Wall Construction, Theo Postulo, who has attended previous club meetings, Kix Citton, who is the Executive Director of the Nanaimo Brain Injury Society, and our speaker Kevin Vowles.

Announcements:

Patrick Maguire seemed reluctant to over-promote the upcoming Shredding fund raising event. Various club members offered details of this event, which will be held on May 18th at Nanaimo North Town Centre. Starts at 10:00 with some prior setup requirements, and ends at 2:00.



Our Daybreak Golf Tournament is a "nine and dine" format. Event will take place on May 31st at the Nanaimo Golf Club. Mosaic will be the gold sponsor of the tournament. Terry Rogers needs to know how many players and how many dinner-only guests. Please let Terry know.

The Hanging Basket of Flowers fund raiser is sold out.

Jeff Boegel announced the Spring Poker Tournament. Funds raised will be shared between Nanaimo Brain Injury Society and our club. See Jeff to volunteer.

The Kidney Walk will be held on June 2nd. Bill Brendon will be participating as will Randy, the man that Bill says is "guarding Bill's left kidney with his life". Bill is accepting donations for this worthy event.



Rotary Moment:

Rod Mont reminded us that Rotary maintains a stable number of members worldwide in spite of 1.2 million new members gained over recent years. Rotary requires new members. Some areas of the world are increasing their membership, but Canada is one of the areas where membership numbers are in decline. Rod referenced the Rotarian magazine article on "5 Points to Building Membership", (an article worth looking up).

Presentation:

Kevin Vowles is the co-coordinator of the program to Prevent Alcohol and Risk related Trauma in Youth (PARTY).

Kevin described the program of "information days" at the Hospital. High school students learn about choices and outcomes from alcohol and drug use during presentations and through visits to the Ambulance Room, Trauma Station, morgue (optional), or other simulations. Students hear from a brain-injury survivor and various presenters on how alcohol affects the brain and related topics.

PARTY is not a "don't drink alcohol" program. It is to provide knowledge to allow for appropriate choices. The program provides an education approach to drug use, which is similar to the information about alcohol use.

The training in PARTY differentiates between "crashes" which are preventable and "accidents" which are unpreventable.

PARTY needs volunteers to guide students through their training day at the hospital. (our club has been involved with this for several years). Becoming a volunteer will require a criminal record check and approximately six hours of training.

Draws:

This would be the final day of our current format for the 50/50 draw. The entire pot (\$661.00) would be won this day. The final draw would be in a format of drawing numbered tickets, then having the ticket holders draw among only 4 cards to find the 7 of hearts. The first three holders of drawn tickets did not pick the winning card. The result was a suspenseful conclusion as the final of 4 drawn tickets would be the winner. Denise Davidson was holder of the fourth drawn ticket and the eventual winner of the final pot. The Foundation draw was won by Councilor Don Bonner.

Sergeant at Arms collected Happy Bucks. We then recited the Four Way Test and said our goodbyes.
