President Ev Boegh opened the meeting with 'O Canada' accompanied by Rod Mont. Our guests this morning were Ila, who is the granddaughter of Graham C, and our presenters from Nanaimo Youth Service Association. Our visiting Rotarian was Ayu, our Exchange Student from Japan.

Graham Calder sorted out the order of breakfast by requiring tables to co-ordinate one of the many socks Graham was wearing with a matching (clean) sock placed on the tables earlier. Very comical; you should have been there.

**Rotary Moment:**

Dave Perry used the experience of creating planter boxes at Newcastle Village to show that Rotary makes many changes in the world and in peoples' lives. Dave suggests that many little things which we take for granted can have significant meaning for others; like the people of Newcastle Village.

**Announcements:**

- Incoming President Doug reminded us that Fireside Chats are coming up. We need to participate to help Doug set direction for the club.
- Also, Doug provided copies of the list of committees and directors. Look at the list and let Doug know if you would like to change the committees of which you are a member.
- Silly Boat Festival is July 14<sup>th</sup> and the club needs paddlers. Tell Doug if you would like to participate.
- Patrick thanked everyone who helped out or showed up for the "Shredding" event. This raise \$2,700. for Polio Plus. Patrick noted that this amount of funding will immunize five thousand children against Polio.
- Patrick also announced the receipt of the final report and cheque from the Rotary District which will provide \$6,000. USD for The Guatemala Project. This provides tutoring for out-of-school children.
- Caitlin announced that the Daybreak Golf Tournament raised over \$15,000. In support of NYSA, Boys and Girls Clubs and Nanaimo Childhood Development Centre. It was a great event with all participants planning to return next year.
- Youth Exchange needs volunteer help for the summer events; drivers, cooks and other support tasks. The program also needs a host family for the incoming student.



**Program:**

Nanaimo Youth Services Association presented an overview of their services and successes. Amy Worth, Anthony Maki and four youth who have benefitted from NYSA programs provided the presentation.



NYSA is a non-profit organization which has been in operation since 1969. Their purpose is, "to encourage and empower youth to meet their best potential in life". Programs are designed for the needs of young people from 15 to 30 years of age. They also provide after-school programs for youth who are 8 to 12 years old.

NYSA programs are focused on skills training, offering expertise in customer service, hospitality industries, landscaping, construction, forestry, culinary arts and in life-skills. These programs include work experience. After-school programs focus on arts & crafts and sports. Summer programs are also offered. Programs are funded by the federal and provincial governments.

"Supportive living" is also provided through NYSA. This service is for children who are permanent wards of the government. Associated programs teach life-skills and independence. NYSA manages two separate housing units for this purpose.

Anthony Maki; the 'job developer' says the programs are focused on people with potential but were not born to opportunity. The best social program is a meaningful job that allows people to participate and grow.

NYSA graduates; Crystal Wyse, Samson Brook and Taylor Mann told of their positive experience and outcomes from participating in NYSA programs.

NYSA is looking for mentors for young people enrolled in NYSA programs.
