Motion to spend \$2500 for Snuneymuxw Canoe which will cost \$23,000 overall including trailer paddles and safety gear. Ken moved, Ron Seconded. Discussion on self sustaining, as used by many other organizations and support of aboriginal community. Carried.

Nelson spoke on 1st April commemorating 100 Years Paul Harris Foundation with start at 6ish.

Jacqueline Mealing Shepherd discussed sustainability in Guatemala, which is poorest in Central America and corrupt. Projects involve listening to the community and their newest project. Wood stoves and specifically the wood used has become more expensive than food. Natural gas stoves cost less than wood stoves and gas for cooking costs even less. Community grants will quadruple our funds in Guatemala.

Lauren Rogers involved with World University Services sponsoring university schooling to international students for the first year and sponsor normally 2 students this year three. Thereafter, they can apply for Canadian Grants and loans. Upcoming Harambee celebration on Thurs April 13.

After chocolate sales, Christine MacAuley is now working/volunteering with the symphony and they book Port Theatre more than 30 times/year. Band members come from all over the island and Vancouver. Major purpose of attendees is social and cool to really feel the music. Maestro is from Montreal and we have to fly him out before each concert. Real economic driver for our community and causes people to move to our community. Musicians visit in schools and symphony now does live performances in schools and Theatre does two major/year shows costing \$1 each. Idea is to encourage grade 4's to appreciate music. Another program is to encourage students to try various instruments and then attend a practice session. Encourage youth to take up music. Symphony youth education fund.
