Bonnie Murrell reflected on the numerous international projects our club is involved, including Guatemala, Nepal and Ghana. Bonnie talked about a telehealth app developed by a Rotarian Doctor from California. The Doctor's club had an ongoing medical project in Nigeria. A shortage of both medical practitioners as well as supplies was making it difficult to provide the needed medical services to those in the most need. With the use of a Rotary Global grant a telehealth app was developed to provide health to everyone, not just the wealthy in Nigeria.
