### Guest Speakers Russ Burke and Craig Richardson

Russ is former president of the Nanaimo Chamber of Commerce

and Craig was Nanaimo's fire chief until his retirement last year. Leadership Vancouver Island is in its eighteenth year, have 300 grads and completed 100 community projects. The next intake year starts this September beginning with a three-day retreat. Each year 18 to 25 students participate and are assigned to smaller groups to work with a community partner on a project. Viu grants 6 credits to any student completing the Leadership Vancouver Island program. Alumni include our very own Doug Lum and Janice Krall.
