Meeting Notes – Sept 29th, 2021, by Robb Mowbray, photos Jodi Rogers

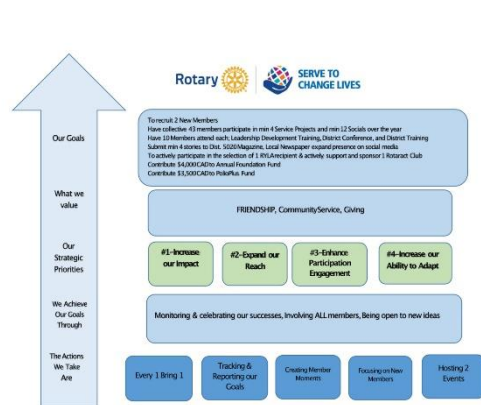
