

**Guest Speaker:** Anne McIntyre with Soap for Hope was our guest speaker. They provide shampoo in new bottles to about 400 organizations. They also provide linens to those in need evacuation centers (stained linens go to the SPCA or are sent for rags). They have been on their own for 3 years. The mission statement: Dignity through Hygiene. Their main customers are high schoolers, seniors, and families. Seniors are the hardest to help as they do not want charity. They have provided linens to refugees such as those from the Ukraine. Their work is labour intensive and repetitive. They have Ace Couriers and Diamond Delivery as their shipping partners. They also work with Helicopters without Borders to get product to remote communities. If you know an organization who would be able to use their product, get them in touch.
