If all of the clubs agree, we will have three years to raise our share of the donation which is \$15,000 and based upon the number of members we have compared to the other Rotary clubs. This is a possible legacy project/donation. We chatted as a group about what the feeling was to move forward with this idea. Graham said he thinks this is a great idea and Denise L. asked if we need to have a fundraiser. Doug L. shared that we already have 40% of the total \$5,000 annual commitment in our annual budget. More to come.

Donna stood and said that our Thailand and Poland exchange students presented on May 14 to PROBUS. Rotary member Cindy Shantz stepped up and taught them to tell stories. The meeting of PROBUS is a fellowship club and 110 people were there to hear their story telling. The students did really well.

President Dave explained that our Daybreak Board can approve small expenditures but for large expenditures, votes will go to the membership.

Rod M.'s birthday is May 16 and we sung to him. The 50/50 was \$47 and Kris won.

Duane stepped in and helped with SAA after Graham had to leave and asked for happy bucks. President Dave closed meeting at 8am. It was a great informative meeting.
