Anna Maria is the Manager of Development and Fundraising for Habitat for Humanity and a 20+ year member of Rotary. Her talk was about an amazing new project for the organization as they look for affordable housing solutions. The mid-Island organization covers the area of Parksville to Duncan. Some facts about Habitat and its services and the new project. For every \$1 spent on their housing, there are \$4 of benefit in the larger community. The new project is an apartment (condo?) building on Metral Drive. It is 25 units, with bachelor, one-, two- and three-bedroom units. 5 units will be fully accessible. It will serve families, seniors, Veterans, couples, singles and those living with disabilities. It is expected to house 50 - 60 people with a turnaround of occupancy every 10 - 13 years. The organization will retain ownership of the building and the occupants will benefit from a rental rebate accrual. The occupants will still be required to do 500 hours of community service.



Daryl K made a few announcements. Rob D., Dave T. and Cathy M. had birthdays (Rob and Dave suffered through our rendition of happy birthday with good grace – Cathy had the smarts to skip the meeting!) Duane S. and his wife Michelle had an anniversary and so did Rod M and Jill M.
