Rod introduced and inducted Pat Knight. Pat is Nanaimo born and worked in and around Nanaimo. He owned several Subways and was very successful with that organization. Currently he is enjoying retirement. Pat has been very involved in our club already. We then had a receiving line to welcome Pat.

Mike H. introduced Tracey Brown and we heard a great presentation about Nanaimo Foundation. The purpose of this Foundation is to be here helping the Community forever and connecting people. It is a Community Leader building networks and is always looking for Funding opportunities. It's their business to build community. They bring donors together with those who are in need. There are a lot of ways to give including 6 ways of gifting. Everyone can make an impact. Tracey shared some Philanthropic contributions and stories. NF are also Grantmakers directly supporting the Community. They gave out over \$1M in 2023. Two of their programmes are: Give where you Live and the Neighborhood small grants fund. A new Fund is being announced soon called Community Prosperity Fund with \$630,000. Data drives their work. They use the Vital Signs report. It is updated every 2 years and helps them understand what is happening in the community. They then can make decisions based on facts. Tracey shared some details from the recent report. Tracey invited us all to learn more about NF and thanked us all.
