Don Bonner fined a bunch of people and then asked for happy dollars –hmmmm!

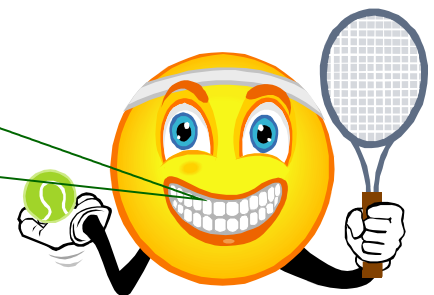
