This morning's guests: San Mahara presented Rotarian Dhiraj Karki, Rotary Club of Hetauda, Nepal, and visitor Bil Sujit Khadra from Vancouver. Our guest speakers: Interact VP Vanessa Young and Past President Kyle McCraig.

Dave Thompson, Sergeant-at-Arms, wrested the reins from Pres. Bill, and managed to somehow confuse most of us into figuring out when to proceed to provender.

Afterwards, Rotarian Dharaj Karki explained that he has been a Rotarian for three years, his Hetauda Club was chartered in 1992, has 29 members and Nepal is District 3292 with 69 Clubs and about 2,500 members.

Speakers Kyle and Vanessa had technical difficulties and proceeded with their presentation "live." The Interact Club has 15 active members from all District High Schools, and regularly meets in St Andrews Church. Over the past years, their Club has provided funds for a dug well, near Sunyani Ghana, with funds captured by a "Water Walk" from Beban Park to St. Andrews Ch. A Literacy Project was to read to Grade 2 Students was a great success and enjoyed by all participants.

Club members attended the 2nd Annual Interact District Conference, held in Oak Bay H.S. with it's primary focus on Shelter Box Canada. There were amazing speakers, including A Channel's Bruce Williams speaking on Jeneece Place, and Peter Sinclair from Loaves & Fishes. Vanessa thanked our Club for providing the snacks and beverages at their Conference.

Another international project by Interact was LED Africa (& our Ray Penner) with the second half of the funds donated Jeff Tomlinson of JD Anderson & Associates. With their \$600 & Jeff's help, they had sufficient funds to light one classroom.

Car wash funds helped Jeneece Place and they were acknowledged with a memorial brick.

Nanaimo District Secondary Students started a "Hygiene Bag" for Nanaimo's street people, with them receiving socks, mitts and toiletries. Their last project supported Canadian Vision Care (CVC) www.canadianvisioncare.com/ with Nanaimo North Rotarian Paul Geneau and others who went to Costa Rica in March to provide basic vision diagnosis and care to the disadvantaged.

Kyle graduates this year to VIU for his Bach. of Arts in Science & Geology, whilst Vanessa has won our Daybreak \$1,000 scholarship for Visual Arts.

As many members are graduating this year, though some members are as young as 12, they plan a recruitment drive with an 80's style dance (Old to them, but new style to some of us) ;-)
