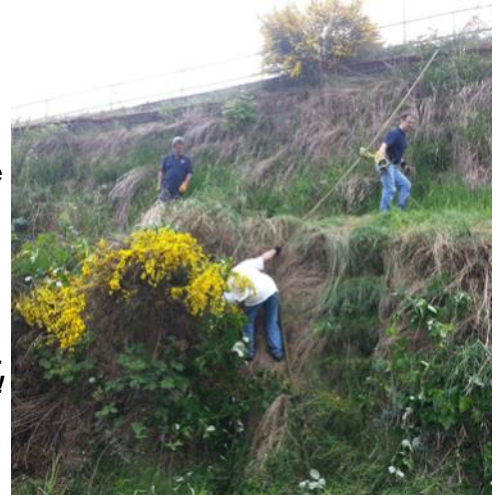

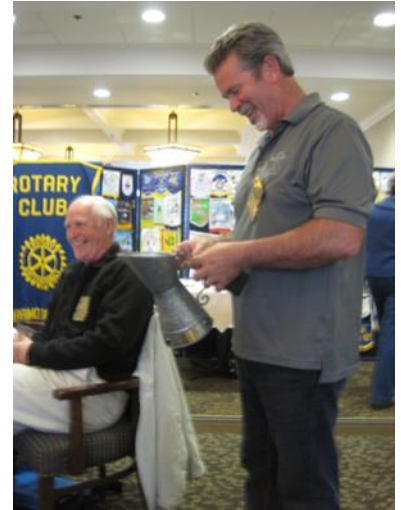
...Wendi, Wendi what went wrong...
