Their main goals are to foster leadership development, raise community awareness, reach your full potential and build

innovative communities. Their Mission is "to seek out and cultivate potential and emerging leaders on Vancouver Island". The programme also allows its students to transfer credits towards an elective for a degree program or the Certificate in Community Leadership from VIU. One of their recent graduates, Charlie Clappis from Huu-ay-aht First Nation, shared his experience. He said that the programme has given him an opportunity to be a leader. Since then, he has joined several organizations in the community. He was involved in organizing hockey, softball game, promoting healthy lifestyle through walk or run events in the community.
