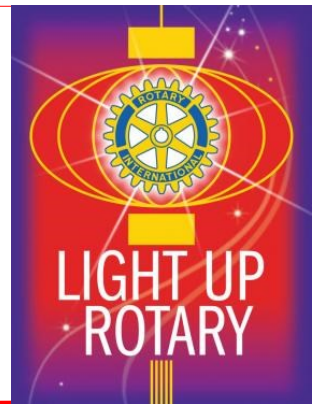

Another week with Don Bonner presiding and Rod Mont at the horn to begin our meeting.

Guests: Dervin Davies and Morgan Brimacombe with Wellington Rotary Interact Club and Diane Ding intro'd by Ken Hammer as an MBA Student from China.

Christine Craigie gave an excellent update on the status of Rotary's polio eradication programmes. Brian Kirkhope asked "Who knows of someone who has had polio?" Every said yes except the three under 35 yoa.. How's that for an effective programme!!

Ken Hammer became the impromptu speaker (Bev Hilton had to pass) on Sunyani Ghana and the handout highlighted many projects that have been completed over the years. We have invested over \$300,000 to date in various infrastructure programmes. This trip included reviewing and assessing past programmes and looking for future ideas. During his latest trip with Diane Ding, he managed 12 Rotary makeups in 18 days. He now has 29 shirts from various Rotary Clubs and discovered that a school is named "Ken Hammer Senior High School" in Goaso Brong Ahafo Region Ghana" with over 500 students.

Diane shared there is no Rotary in China, but with this trip she understands PP, PE, DLTA, and other Rotary acronyms. The things that Rotary accomplishes are very meaningful to Diane and she realizes that these are things she wants to do.

Update: Senyo is recuperating after the bus crash and is now using crutches in rehab. He appreciates the \$ support and good wishes he received from everyone.
