By popular demand Doug returned for his second Rotary Minute in the last three weeks and confirmed how big a part Rotary has become in his life and that many of his fellow Rotarians have become good friend.

Guest Speaker Makenzie Leine RPF

Makenzie is the manager of Government and Community Relations for Island Timberlands. She is also responsible to for all environmental certification for the company. Makenzie comes from a logging family and spent the first 8 years of her life living in a logging camp.

Island Timberlands is owned by a pension fund which allows them to plan on a longer time frame, not overly concerned about quarterly results.

Some fun facts about Island Timberlands:

- They own 255,000 hectares of land on the island and about 2% is actively logged every year
- It takes about 60 years for a harvest
- They bought the landholdings of Weyerhaeuser when they got out of B.C.
- About 5% of logging production is from private lands and the balance from land owned by the crown
- Logging on private land generates 1 billion in revenue and about 5000 jobs
- They are investing in new technology to make the work place safer for their employees and contractors

Makenzie advised that if the Softwood lumber agreement does not get renewed she anticipates that there will be push in the states to impose significant tariffs on Canadian lumber, which will result in the search for new markets.
