Our guests this week is a potential Rotarian of the name Mike Smithe, visiting Rotarians were Steve and Joanne Wallace.

Terry Rogers delivered our rotary minute and mentioned how wonderful it was to have familiar faces at the Smythe LLP open house and how great the bar service was.

Steve Wallace who runs a driving school was our speaker for the morning and he came to speak to us about the senior driving program ran by the ICBC.

At the age of 80, (heads up Ron) seniors receive a letter from ICBC mentioning that they need to see their doctor to see if they need a driving test.

Most seniors rush to their doctor to determine if they need a drivers test. However, Steve mentioned that you should bring proof of good driving history. This includes a driver's abstract, insurance documents showing good drivers discount and a letter from a drivers instruction program mentioning the seniors great driving. This information is useful as without the information the doctor does not have much to base their decision and will send most seniors to the drivers test.

If a senior is sent to the drivers program they must take a memory test, which is often failed by seniors and non seniors alike. As such, many seniors must take a drivers test, which is difficult as the test happens in a strange car and in a area they do not know. To exemplify his point, Steve tried to determine if the club knew the driving rules and the majority of the club failed. If a senior is to fail the drivers test, they must get a learners licence and relearn to drive with family and friends. This can be harmful to the seniors confidence and the family dynamic.
