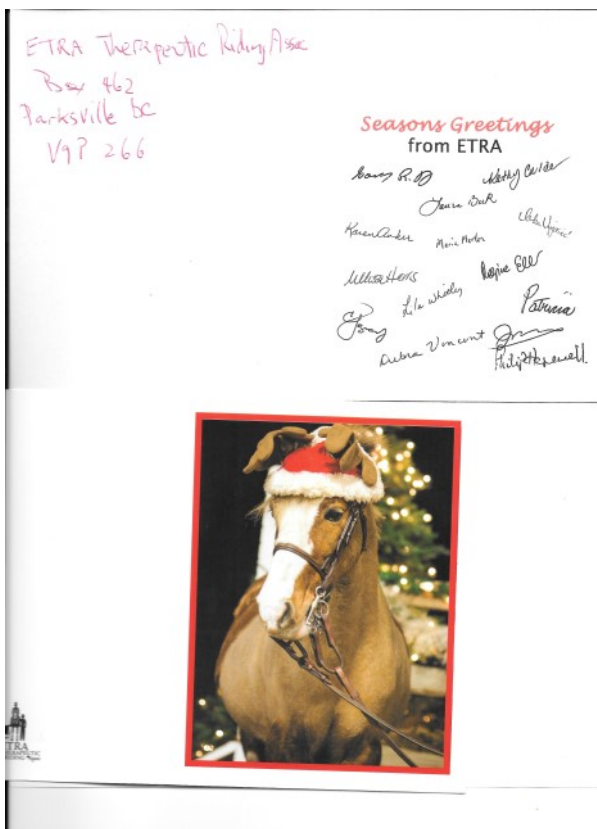

Our presentation today was from Doug, Ken, Neil and Bev Hilton. They spoke to us about the Mid Island Group, which is a partnership of the Vancouver Island rotary clubs. MIG for short.

The MIG is a partnership of Island Rotarays club with the goal of combining funds to take advantage of Rotary International and Governmental matching programs in an effort to leverage the combined funds of the rotary clubs to impact lives worldwide.

Their current objective is to buy blood fridges for Guana. The main reason for the fridges is to assist birthing mothers and young children with blood needs during the birthing process.

Current fridges are rather small and most donations have to come from relatives as its needed, since Gauna has tough travel conditions, this may not be possible for all mothers.



The total project cost is \$100,500, but most of the funds will come from matching programs.
