Our speaker for this morning was our own San Mahara. San described his trip through Nepal this past summer and the work that Rotary is doing in that country. San's photos provided better understanding of the conditions in Nepal. This included school structures built before and after the recent earthquake, which need replacement.

The school is now purchasing land so that they can build a more permanent structure than the schools which were built on leased land. San proposed raising \$4,000.00 (USD) and applying for a Rotary grant to assist in this construction. San's children were surprised at the difference in attending a school in Nepal from the education and building that they have here in Nanaimo. San's presentation included photos of the earthquake damage remaining in both poor areas and tourist areas of Nepal. San also visited a local Rotary club in Nepal which is restoring another damaged school.
