Rotary Minute was provided by Doug Pearson, who reminded us of the work of Rotary World Community Service and the 24 club "Mid-Island Group", which includes our club.



Guest Speaker:

Our program was provided by Scott Saywell, newly appointed superintendent of Nanaimo and Ladysmith School District. Scott began with a photo of a young Kindergarten aged student who would be expected to graduate in the year 2033. This underlined the changing face of education and the need to look forward at learning with technology. "Technology has changed everything, including education" This understanding must be applied to curriculum, instruction, and assessment and reporting.



In the past, curriculum was "one mile wide and one inch thick". Teachers are now open to going deeper into content when this provides learning options. Teaching competencies is considered more important than memorizing curriculum. Scott suggests that schools need to be changed to allow "powerful learning". Reporting of student progress has moved away from letter-grades to provide a less biased, more complete picture of progress. The challenge in education remains extending learning to populations from lower socio-economic status with the end of improved graduation rates. The Nanaimo Ladysmith School District has a focus to improve graduation rates among our indigenous population.
